2023 TOTAL IMPACT STATS

- 71,753 first responders, medical staff, veterans, children and seniors with disabilities have benefited from 1 FUR 1's free animal assisted programs.
- 91 certified therapy animals (dogs, mini-horses and mini pig) worked last year to bring therapeutic healing to people in need.



- 4,955 animal assisted activity (AAA), therapy (AAT) and virtual (ARE) sessions
 have been done at hospitals, hospice, long-term care facilities, assisted living
 communities, courthouses, victim service agencies and offices.
- 159 U.S. facilities received free animal assisted services across eight states.



- 1. Donations Declined 1.7% the First Downward Trend in Dollars Since 2012
- 2. Though Individual Giving Decreased, Other Giving Types Saw Gains
- 3. Donor-advised funds (DAFs) aexperienced growth in the total amount of grants headed to nonprofits for most of the largest grantors a notion that pushes back on the perception that many DAF owners are holding onto the money designated to their DAFs.
- 4. 62% of Americans Are Unaware of the Fact that Giving Is Declining
- 5. Donors Who Stopped Giving Said Wealthier People Should Give Instead
- 6. Salary Competition Was the Main Barrier to Employee Recruitment and Retention
- 7. Nonprofits Average Nearly \$6,000 in Fundraising per Email Campaign or about \$1.11 per email contact
- 8. Almost Half of Younger Donors Are Likely to Scan a QR Code on Direct Mail Appeals
- 9. The Post-Pandemic Slump for Peer-to-Peer Fundraising Ended, With a 19% Boom
- 10. Monthly Giving Rose 11% and Accounted for Nearly a Third of Online Giving
- 11. 70% of Nonprofits Struggle to Get Board Members to Participate in Fundraising Activities
- 12. 29% of Taxpayers Took a Tax Deduction for Charitable Contributions in 2020
- 13. Our Earliest Indicator of 2023 Shows Giving Is Continuing to Trend Downward










GRANT GIVING SUMMARY

YEAR TO DATE IMPACT


During 1 FUR 1's lifetime 237,731 people were impacted by our

free animal assisted service programs since we started in August, 2014!

2023 was our biggest year to date where 1 FUR 1 touched the lives of 71,753 people in need of alternative healthcare by offering free animal assisted therapy and activity sessions. That's 69% above our annual target of 42,500.



2023 Total Sessions by Type



A YEAR IN REVIEW







Each of 1 FUR 1's program partners overcame challenges and seized opportunities which led to exceed our annual impact goal of 42,500 people impacted by 32% and deliver noticeable operational growth. Such as:



Canine Advocates program merges with Care House of Oakland County securing its future and possibility for expansion nationwide.

Hearts and Hooves Therapy transitioned from a single operator to a leader managing 8+ therapy mini horse teams and (METSA) Miniature Equine Therapy Standards Association consultant and evaluator.





Newfie Therapy doubled the number of working dog team and received 1MM end of life donation which is designated for the build of the first ever Wellness Center (name TBD)

Kindred Therapy Minis doubled the facilities visited each month while securing integration with American Red Cross as the official (and only) Emergency Response Team with therapy mini horses.







AAA GRANT PROGRAM PERFORMANCE





AAA GRANT PROGRAM PERFORMANCE








AAT GRANT PROGRAM PERFORMANCE




What's Next:
